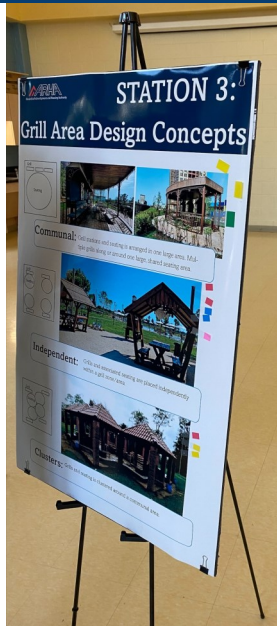


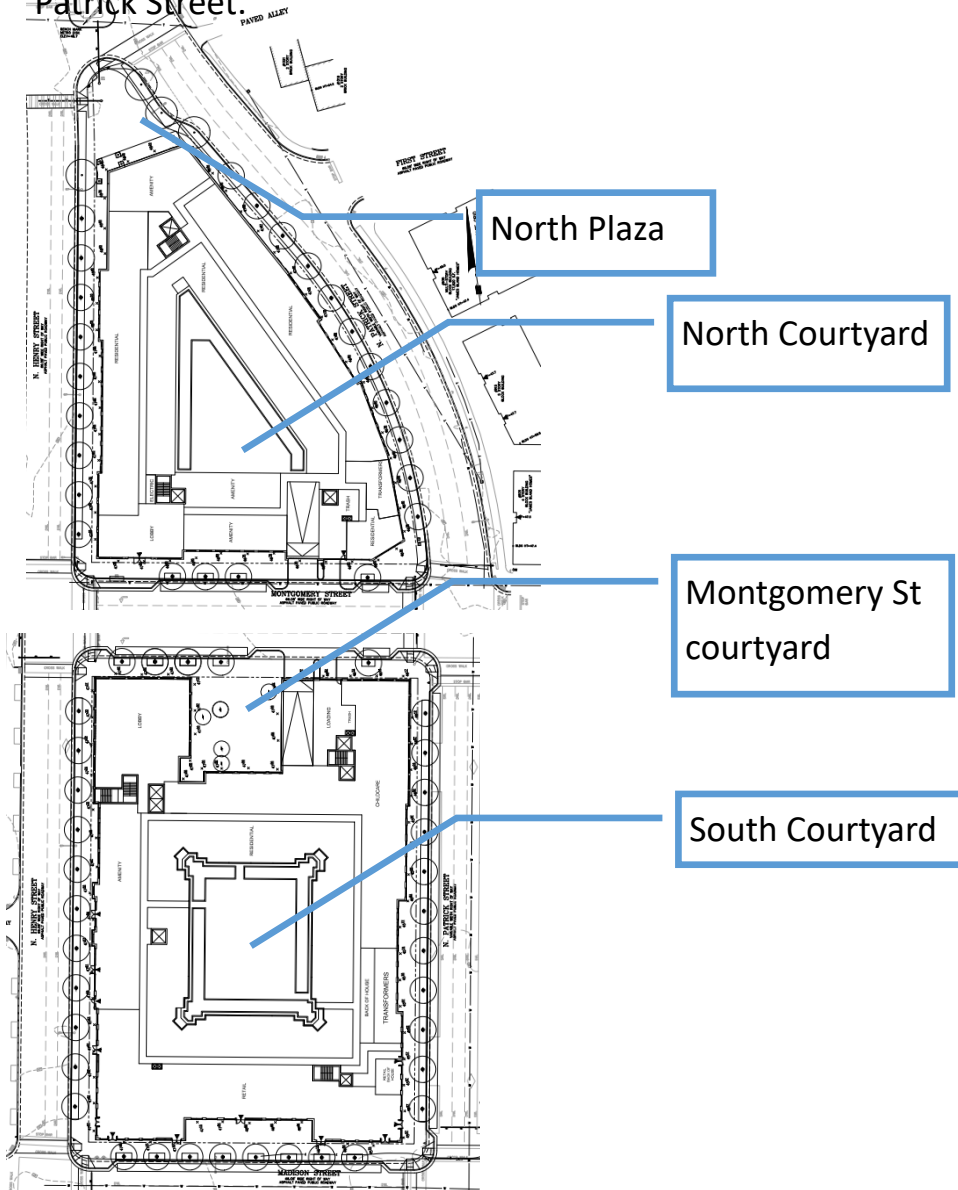
# GREEN SPACE RESIDENT WORKSHOP



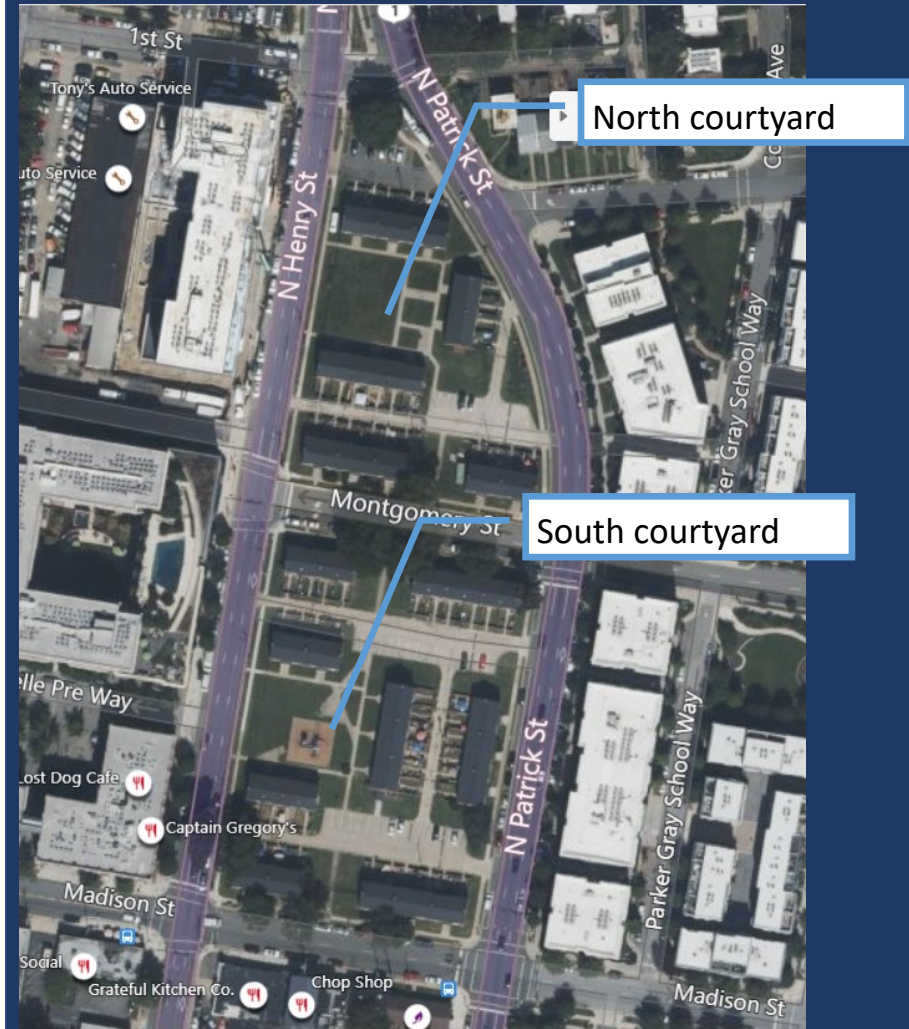

# Concept 3 Layout

The proposed site plan includes: a north plaza, north interior courtyard, Montgomery St courtyard and south interior courtyard. The Montgomery Street courtyard houses a play area to be shared with the daycare proposed on N. Patrick Street.

The exiting site plan includes two courtyards centered in the middle of each block. The south courtyard includes a playground for resident use.

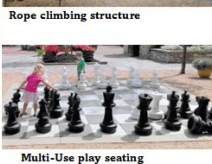

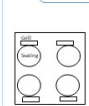

## STATION 3: Grill Area Design Concepts



**Communal:** Grill stations and seating is arranged in one large area. Multiple grills along or around one large, shared seating area.



**Independent:** Grills and associated seating are placed independently within a grill zone/area.



**Clusters:** Grills and seating is clustered around a communal area.
